Moss Valley Walk - Starting at Ridgeway, Sheffield S12 3YD

<u>Directions from M1 south:</u>

- Leave at Junction 30, take 1st exit at the roundabout towards Eckington on the A6135. Keep on this road for approx 2 miles
- At Atco crossroads/traffic lights continue forward on the A6135 for approx 3.5 miles towards Mosborough
- Continue through Mosborough
- Go straight through crossroads at Mosborough for approx 0.5 miles
- Turn left onto Quarry Hill B6054 (Ridgeway Arms pub on the left) for approx 0.6miles (sign posted Gleadless)
- Turn left onto Main road, Ridgeway (sign posted Ridgeway Craft Centre)
- Go straight down the hill until you reach the Bridge Inn pub at the bottom of the hill
- Take a left just before the pub into the walk car park (do not park in the pub car park)
- Time from M1 approx 14 mins

Directions from M1 North:

- Leave at Junction 30, take the 3rd exit at the roundabout towards Eckington on the A6135. Keep on this road for approx 2 miles
- Use instructions above

Places to Eat

- 1. The Bridge Inn (next to car park)
- 2. The Swan (turn right out of car park & it's on left, across from Ridgeway craft centre)
- 3. Ridgeway Craft Centre (turn right out of the car park & it is on your right near the top of the hill)
- 4. The Phoenix (right out of car park, straight to the top of the hill, bear left & turn left onto the B6054, it is approx 300 yards on your left)..... best food & biggest car park (need to book tables if eating on a Sunday)

The Walk - Approx 2 hours (long walk)


- 1. Leave the car park by the path running around the pond & continue along it with the stream on the right
- 2. Cross over the stile & go through the field, keeping the stream on your right
- 3. Cross the 2nd stile & continue to follow the path
- 4. Cross the stream & carry on to your right, passing through the kissing gate
- 5. Bear left & continue to follow the path down the valley with the stream still on right (pass a pond on the left)
- 6. Do not cross the stile into the wood, cross the stream over the bridge & bear left following the field edge
- 7. Follow the path into Twelve Acre Wood and continue along the track

Short walk (blue colour)

- 1. When you reach the cross roads you can turn left over the bridge & turn left into Cadman Woods & following the path, keeping the river on your left
- 2. At the top of the path turn left & cross over the stile into a large open field (Bowercinder Hill)
- 3. Continue along the path until you reach the stile
- 4. Cross over the stile & follow path, keeping river on your left
- 5. At the end of the path cross the stile & bear right onto the path (heading back to the car park)
- 6. Continue on the path, keeping the river on your left & head back to the car park

Long Walk (pink colour)

- 1. Carry straight on, after a short distance you will see the Seldom Seen Engine House on the right
- 2. At next cross roads carry straight on
- 3. At the end of the track turn left onto the road
- 4. Bear left & cross the bridge over the river
- 5. Turn left back onto the track
- 6. Continue straight on at the next cross roads, through the woods (open field to your left)
- 7. At the next cross roads go straight on into Cadman Woods & follow step No2 of the short walk
